



## SWPPP PROGRAM

## Project Location:

Various sites in Utah, Arizona, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon and Wyoming

## Project Description:

Wilding Engineering has developed a strong stormwater program to service residential, commercial and industrial sites in Utah, Arizona, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon and Wyoming. Basic stormwater environmental compliance begins with the design of a site-specific Erosion Control Plan (ECP) and preparation of the corresponding Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). Both are required by the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Stormwater General Permit for Construction Activities and must be completed prior to applying for permit coverage under NPDES. ALL sites whose area of disturbed activity exceeds one (1) acre are required to have an ECP and SWPPP. Once these are complete, application for NPDES permit coverage is requested by submitting a Notice of Intent (NOI). It must be certified by the owner/operator of the construction site and kept on site during construction. Once the construction site is complete and the site is stabilized, a Notice of Termination (NOT) requesting for permit coverage to end is submitted.

Our services include the preparation and delivery of all the required documents including: site specific SWPPP and ECP, NOI, completed NOT to be submitted post construction, copy of the NPDES General Permit, inspection forms and a SWPPP binder to be kept on-site. Wilding can also provide training that covers the SWPPP process including site monitoring and inspection procedures, documentation and permitting. Application and installation of Best Management Practices (BMPs) are also covered in detail during training sessions.
